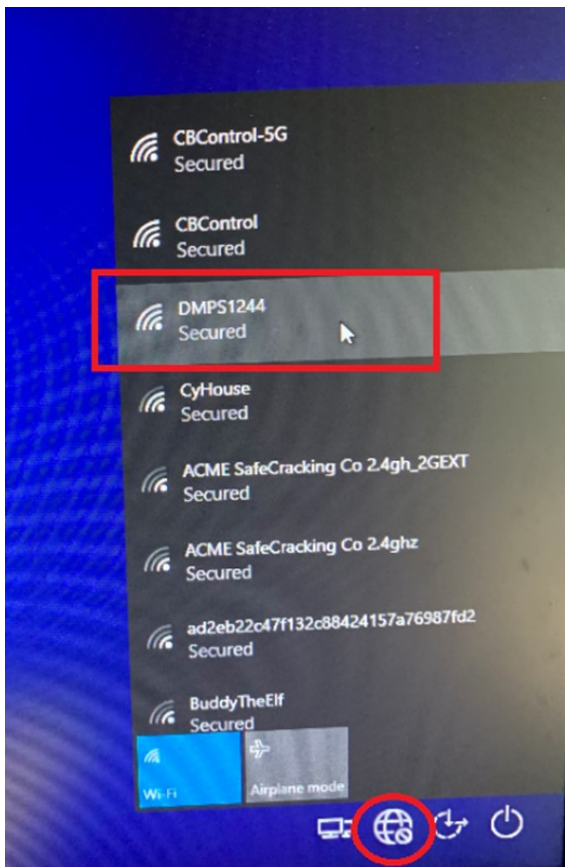


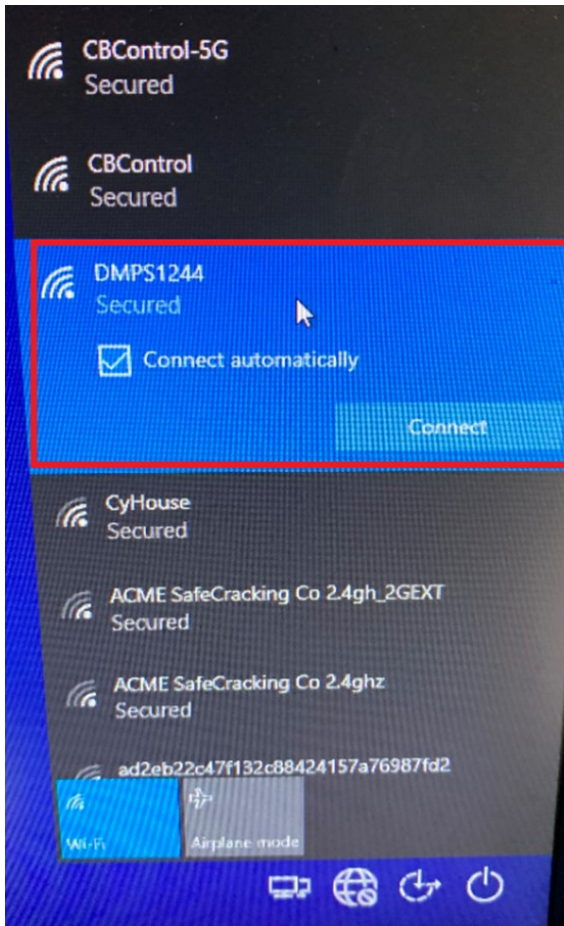
## Alcatel Hot Spot Directions

If you have an Alcatel hot spot, you can connect to the Internet through a Wi-Fi connection. This hot spot is for school work and should not be used for personal devices. Follow these steps to connect your DMPS computer to your hot spot.

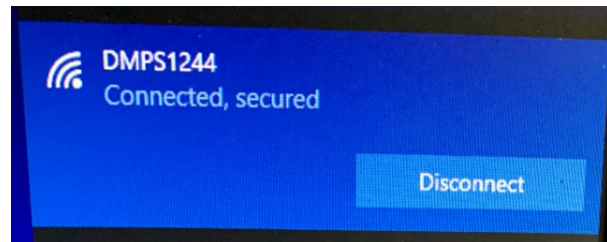
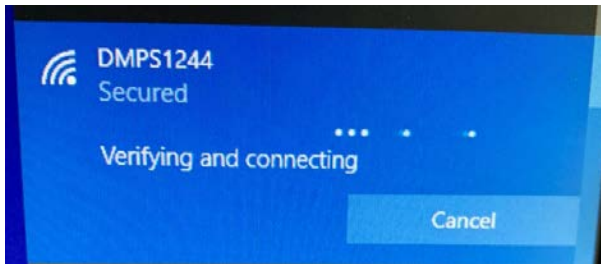
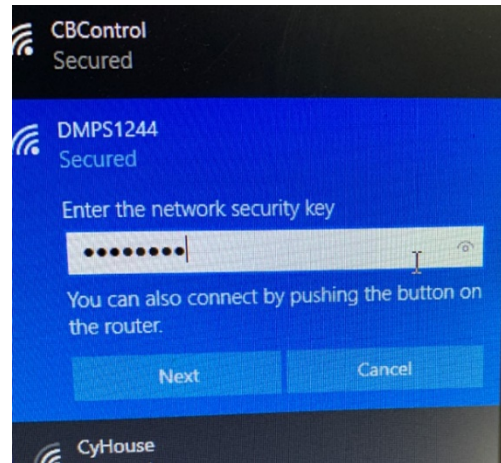
1. Plug in your hot spot if it needs to be charged.
2. Your hot spot uses a cellular signal (like a cell phone) so if you can place it near a window, you will get your strongest signal and better speeds.
3. Turn on your hot spot. Power button is on the top of the hot spot. You should see the blue lights on the front of the hot spot light up.



4. Once your hot spot is powered on and has a signal, then you can connect your computer to it. Press CTRL+ALT+DELETE on your laptop to bring up the login screen.
5. Click on the "Internet" icon in the bottom-right corner of your screen to display available wireless networks.
6. Locate the network name that starts with DMPSXXXX. The "XXXX" will be a set of numbers, and will be different than what you see on this screen.
7. Select the DMPSXXXX network



8. Check the “Connect automatically” box and click “Connect.”
9. Type in the password that is on your sticker and click the “Next” button.
10. Wait for it to connect.
11. It will indicate that you are connected and secure.



12. Once you are connected to Wi-Fi, you can continue to log into your computer. See Student Device guide for further instructions.
